



Nicholls State University – Morrison MSDI Program

MHC DI has formed a partnership with Nicholls State University to give interns the chance to enroll in a fully online, 36-credit-hour Master of Science in Clinical Nutrition and Dietetics Leadership Program. The non-thesis degree offers students an environment that is flexible enough for students to complete the internship program and a graduate degree simultaneously. Course materials are posted online and can be completed at home. Assignments include video presentations, case studies, and writing assignments. Students also can interact with other students and faculty through online discussion forums

Admission and Application Requirements:

The curriculum requires 36 credit hours of coursework, which includes 6 credit hours of non-thesis research and other core courses such as Leadership Theories, Leadership in Clinical Nutrition, Food Systems Management, and Public Policy and Advocacy in Dietetics.

The admission requirements for Nicholls State University are as follows:

- Admission to the University and to Graduate Studies
- Admission requirements into the master's program include acceptance into the Dietetic Internship Program or the following:
- Bachelor's degree and a DPD Verification statement from an accredited Didactic Program in Dietetics, Dietetic Internship Program, or confirmation of registered dietitian credentials.
- Undergraduate GPA: minimum of 2.8
- Conditional admissions with the approval of the program admissions committee.
- Application, required documents, and application fee submitted through the <u>Nicholls State</u> University application portal

Program Costs:

Tuition is \$444 per credit hour including fees. Our MS Program students do not pay out-of-state tuition. Therefore, the cost of the entire program is approximately \$16,000.
