



The University of Tennessee Martin – Morrison MSDI Program

MHC DI has partnered with The University of Tennessee Martin to allow interns to enroll in a fully online, 30-credit-hour, <u>Master of Science in Family and Consumer Sciences</u> <u>dietetics concentration</u>. The program allows students to pursue a combined master's degree and dietetic internship simultaneously for a clinically focused dietetic internship. Students who successfully complete the internship and the graduate program will be awarded the verification statement from MHC for the student to be eligible to sit for the Examination of Registered Dietitians (RD).

Admission and Applications Requirements:

Students will complete a total of 30 hours of graduate coursework in a variety of relevant nutrition topics. Year 1 consists solely of online courses (9 hours Fall, 9 hours Spring, and 6 hours Summer). Year 2 consists of additional online courses (6 hours Fall), while concurrently beginning internship rotations with Morrison Healthcare. Students graduate from UT Martin in December with an MS in Family and Consumer Sciences and then transfer to Morrison's full supervision to finish internship rotations and receive the verification statement. Refer to the UT website for full application details.

The admission requirements for UT Martin are as follows:

- Complete DICAS before applying to UT Martin
- No GRE requirement
- Minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA
- Application deadline for Fall 2024: July 23, 2025
- Application, required documents, and application fee submitted through the UT application portal
